RULES AND REGULATION OF KALINGA BIKASH

- Name of the society: **KALINGA BIKASH**
 At/po- Kalabuda, via- Garadpur
 Dist- Kendrapara. Pin- 754153
- Establishment : The Society has been established on 01.04.2002
- Title : These rule shall be called Rules and Regulation of Kalinga Bikash
- Name : The names of the Society shall be Kalinga Bikash
- Location : The registered office of the Society shall be located At/Po- Kalabuda, Via-Garadpur, Dist.- Kendrapara and may be shifted to any other place in the area as the Executive Committee may decide from time to time.
- Jurisdiction : Throughout the state of Orissa.
- Membership : Any person who has attained the age of 18 years and pay Rs.500.00 would be entitled to be a member as the society. The Membership would be thrown into all irrespective of caste and creed or sex.
- Duration : a) Any member who does not attend 3 consecutive meeting will cease to be member of the Executive Body of the Society.
 b) A member will cease to be member if he/she dies resign become of unsound mind, insolvent or is convicted or a criminal offence involving turpitude.
 c) If a member is engaged in activities detrimental to the aims and object of the Society and Committee will have right to remove him from membership subject to the approval of the General Body meeting
 d) Voluntary resignation.
- Office Bearers : The following office bearers of the society shall constitute the Executive Committee President Vice-President, Secretary, Jt. Secretary, Treasurer. They shall be elected by the general body and their terms of office will be three years
- President : a) Being the supreme authority he is to preside over the meeting of all kinds He is responsible to find ways and means, to strengthen the financial position of the organisation.

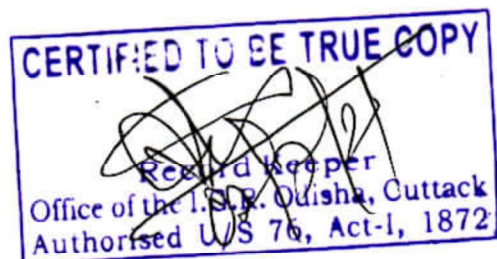

- b) Take disciplinary action against the members with the approval of the General Body
- : He shall act in absence of the President formally the arrangement is a step gap one.
- : a) He is responsible for implementing the policies laid down by the Governing Body.
- b) He shall have the power to appoint any person or persons to work for the Society and shall also have the power to terminate such appointment made by him.
- e) He shall have the necessary powers that are essential to run the institution, rejects/programmes of the society and the day to day affairs of the society.
- d) He shall be change of the deeds documents, records e accounts register, other books of the Society shall be responsible for their correct and up-to-date maintenance.
- e) He shall have all such powers to receive grants funds from Government & Non Government agencies and borrow/receive loans from financing institutions like RGVN, IDBI, D C. Handicrafts. KVIC, NMDFC, RKM etc. on behalf of the Society.
- f) He is authorised to sign all documents agreements relating loans, funds and Grant-in-Aid on behalf of the Society.
- : a) He is responsible for successful maintenance of cash account of the organisation.
- b) He is to receive and collect the sums due to the organisation for its members of others.
- c) He is retain Rs 2000,with him to meet the day to day expenditure and sum more than that shall be deposited in any local Nationalised Bank/Banks against the Secretary. In case of withdrawal signature of any two members including the Secretary of mandatory.
- d) He is to find out ways and means for organisation to strengthen its internal source of income.

1. **Fund:**

Funds of the society constitute as follows

- i) Membership fees.
- ii) Grant-in-Aid from States & National Government
- iii) Charity show and cultural activities.
- iv) Sale proceeds of IGP products.
- v) Grant-in-Aid from any Non-Government, Private or Government undertaking Body and Income Tax payers and any Agency.
- vi) Loan/Borrow money from different Finance/Development Institutions like RGVN, RMK, KVIC, DC. Handicrafts, SIDI, NABARD etc.
- vii) Contributions subscriptions.

1. **INVESTMENT CLAUSE:** The funds of the Society shall be invested in the modes specified under the provisions of Sec.13 (1) (d) with reference to Sec.11(5) of the income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time.

2. **BANK OPERATION & ACCOUNT :**

All Bank Accounts in the name of the organisation shall be operated the Secretary and anyone executive member of the organisation jointly behalf of the organisation.

3. **AUDIT :**

The accounts of the society shall be audited by qualified auditor appointed by society A copy of the annual audit report will be sent to the respective funding agencies as well as the to the Addl. Registrar of Societies. Every year the accounts shall be closed by 31st March.

4. **AMENDMENTS :**

The Memorandum & Bye-Laws of the society may be amended or modified by passing 2/5th majority of total members present and voting of the Governing Body and same shall be communicated to the Registrar Society Orissa for approval.

- i) No amendment to the memorandum of Association / Byelaws/Rule and Regulations shall be made which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of Sections 2(15), 11, 12, & 13 & 80 G of the income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time. Further No amendment shall be carried out without the prior approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax.

5. **IRREVOCABILITY CLAUSE:** The Society formed shall be irrevocable.

6. **BENEFICIARY CLAUSE:** The Benefits of the Society shall be open to all irrespective of caste creed or religion.

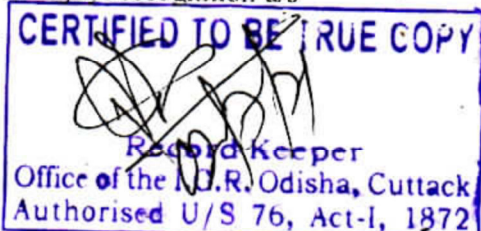
7. **UTILISATION CLAUSE:**

The funds , of the society shall be solely utilized for achievement of the objects of the Society and no payment shall be made to the members by way of profit interest/dividends.

DISSOLUTION :

- i) The society may be dissolved by 3/5th of members upon dissolution of the society the assets of the society shall be handed over to a registered society having similar aim and objects of Govt. after clearing up all its debts and liabilities.

In the event of dissolution or winding of the society the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed among the Members of the Governing Body but the same shall be transferred to another charitable trust/Society whose objects are similar to those of this trust/society and which enjoys recognition u/s 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time.

On the event of any dispute among the members or otherwise the matters shall be referred to Registrar the Societies Orissa whose decision shall be final and binding.

8. RESIDUARY POWER :

Absence of specific provision in this Bye-Law to deal with a particular matter question or issue shall not be bar to appropriate action being taken by the Executive Committee if such an action he deemed necessary furtherance of interest of the Society.

9. LEGAL ACTION :

All legal proceedings by or against the society shall be instituted in the name of the society shall be represent by the secretary on behalf of the society.

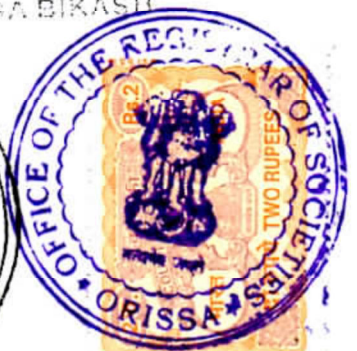
